Our lesson objectives for this week:


- To learn we are called to be fathers and mothers of nations

Fitness Fun

Follow the simple instructions on the pyramid to get an effective fun work out.





Lesson Time

Opening Activity: Grab three or four MnM's or smarties. For every colour there is a question Blue = Share what you like to do for fun.

Red = What is your favourite food?

Yellow = Which place would you like to visit in South Africa?

Brown = Which place would you like to visit in the world?

Purple = What is your favourite verse in the Bible?

Orange = If you met the president, what would you say to him?

Let the kids eat the sweets after they have had their turn.

Say: Today we will be talking about Abraham and Sarah who were people of faith. We will learn to see ourselves the way God sees us so we can believe what He says about us. When we believe right, we will speak right.

Pray with me: Father God, thank You for this day. Teach me your word today so I can see myself the way You see me. I believe Your word. Thank You for making me a world changer. In Jesus' name. Amen

Repeat the declaration: I believe God's word. I speak it and I live it.

Lesson:

Say:: Abraham and Sarah were very old and could not have children. God had promised them that He would give them a son. God had actually promised them that they would have many children. God changed their names (previously Abram and Sara) to their new names. Abraham means father of nations and Sarah which means princess. They started calling themselves by these names.

Say: Abraham and Sarah had to wait a long (loooooong)time to have a baby.

Ask: Does anyone know how long Abraham and Sarah had to wait for the promise God would give them? Abraham had to wait until he was one hundred years old and Sarah had to wait until she was ninety years old to have a baby.

(Ask if the kids know anyone who is a hundred or ninety years old). Abraham and Sarah had to wait for twenty-five years to have a baby.

Say: Twenty-five years is a very long time to wait. During those twenty-five years that Abraham and Sarah waited, they chose to believe that God would give them the baby that He promised them. They refused to doubt. They knew that God would make His promise happen even if they did not know how.

Say: Boys and girls, we need to spend time with God, learning His word and praying to Him. When God gives us a promise as we spend time with Him, we need to believe what He says even though we do not know how long or how this promise will happen.

Say: In His word God says of us that we have the same promise as Abraham and Sarah. God has called us to be fathers and mothers of nations. What does this mean? This means we can help people, like a mom and dad would, to know Jesus and follow Him. We can help people by praying for them and by helping them know that Jesus loves them. This is how we change the world.

Repeat the declaration: I believe God's word. I speak it and I live it.



Say: Who does God say you are? (get the kids to repeat)

- •I am loved by God
- I am a child of God
- ·II am preferred by God
- ·I am chosen to do God's will
- ·I am called to do great things for God on this earth

Repeat the declaration: I believe God's word. I speak it and I live it.

Application:

Say: God has called you to love people and to help them know Him. You need to believe that God wants to use to do great things for Him. We are going to pray for God to help us.

Pray after me: "Father God, thank You for loving me always. Please forgive me where I have not fully believed Your word. Please forgive me where I did not think you want to use me to do great things for You. Thank You that Your blood removes the doubt and fills me with faith. I will speak Your word and live it. In Jesus name, Amen."

• Pray for three people who need to know Jesus this week.

Repeat the declaration: I believe God's word. I speak it and I live it.

Declarations of the blood of Jesus

When we speak about what the blood of Jesus has done for us, we are changed to be just like Him so we can love all people the way He loves them. Let us declare the blood of Jesus has done for us.

- By the blood of Jesus, I have been redeemed from the power of the enemy.
- By the blood of Jesus, all my sins are forgiven.
- Because I spend time with other Christians, the blood of Jesus cleanses me from sin.
- By the blood of Jesus, I am justified, and God sees me as if I have never sinned.
- By the blood of Jesus, I am sanctified and set apart for God's holy purpose.

Repeat the declaration: I believe God's word. I speak it and I live it.

Devotion plans:

The devotions are aimed to help each child spend daily quiet time with the Lord through Hisword. If you have the means, assist each child to create a special place and help allocate a special time for their devotion. Younger children: we encourage you to spend a few minutes a day reading the scripture toyour child and helping them say the declaration.

Older children: help the children to read the daily scripture, reflect on what the L and then write their own declaration for the day.
