All about the lesson

Read the text:

Genesis 15:5-6

Then the Lord took Abram outside and said to him, "Look up into the sky and count the stars if you can. That's how many descendants you will have!" And Abram believed the Lord, and the Lord counted him as righteous because of his faith.

Declaration:

I believe every promise from the word of God

Memory verse:

Hebrews 11:6

"And it is impossible to please
God without faith. Anyone who
wants to come to him must
believe that God exists and that
he rewards those who sincerely
seek him."

Lesson points:



God encourages us to visualise: God told Abraham to step out of his tent so he could see the stars.

A hero keeps their eyes on their promise of God



Visualising the promise
strengthens our faith: Abraham
was lacking confidence in the
promise, but when he was able to
see the stars with his own eyes,
his doubt disappeared and his
faith grew. We grow in our ability
to see the dream of God when we
spend time in the word of God.
The word of God is the seed from
which God's promise can come to
pass.

A hero is stronger when they see the promises of God.

Instruction:

Show/Project a picture of:

- 1. A happy family: speak to the children about the dream of God for their families, which is to be whole, at peace and serving God together.
 - Declare the promise together: As for me and my house, we will serve the Lord!
- 2. <u>A champion:</u> Speak to the children about places where they may have felt like failures, at home, school or sport. Ask them to visualize themselves as champions in Christ. Declare the promise together: I can do all things through Christ who gives me strength.
- Encourage the children to keep dreaming, visualizing and speaking God's promise for each area of their lives.
