

Power in the blood of Jesus:

Objective:

- Teach kids that God heals all places of our brokenness.
- Teach kids that after healing God uses us to be instruments of His healing.
- Allow the Holy Spirit to minister healing to the kids.

Declare: Declare: The blood of Jesus makes me whole and new.
(please make bold actions with the declaration)

Opening:

Let the kids watch the clip of the day and let them answer basic questions:

- What was happening with the girl in the story?
- What caused her to feel broken? (words of people, mean people, being ignored)
- What did she receive to heal her heart?
- Did she want revenge after her heart was healed?
- What did she do to all the people after Jesus healed her broken heart?

Lesson:

John 19:34 (NKJV)

But one of the soldiers pierced His side with a spear, and immediately blood and water came out.

- Sometimes people do things that make our hearts sore.
- Sometimes our hearts can be hurt when we lose someone that we love.
- God wants us to forgive people when they hurt us or do things that make us unhappy.
- When we forgive, God comes and he helps us.
- We can ask him to fix our hearts so that we are not so sad about what happened anymore.
- Even if terrible things have happened to us, God can heal our hearts so we can be happy and whole.

(explain the word 'whole' – not broken, not sad, not hurt).

- Explain that Jesus was sent to Earth to heal, preach, teach, love, care, and show how much God loved His people.
- Most importantly, He came to die so that we might have eternal life. He took care of our hurts inside and out. He has come back to life so that we might live.
- As we consider His life and work, and consider our hurts and concerns, we take hope in remembering that Jesus promised to be with us always.
- He heals physical hurts, but most importantly He heals our inner trouble. Jesus cares for us always!

Application:

- Pray for restoration from hurts.

Activity:

Draw a heart – colour it and write “My heart is whole and new”

PRAYER: “Thank you Lord that you help me to forgive others. Please forgive me my sin. Thank you for the blood that came from the heart of Jesus. Because of this blood, my heart is no longer broken. Your blood takes away all the pain and helps me to love others the way You meant for me to. In Jesus name, Amen.

Declarations of the blood of Jesus

When we speak about what the blood of Jesus has done for us, we are changed to be just like Him so we can love like Him. So, speak about what the blood of Jesus has done for you.

- By the blood of Jesus, I have been redeemed from the power of the enemy.
- By the blood of Jesus, all my sins are forgiven.
- Because I spend time with other Christians, the blood of Jesus cleanses me
- By the blood of Jesus, I am justified and God sees me as if I have never sinned.
- By the blood of Jesus, I am sanctified and set apart for God’s holy purpose
