

## **Power in the blood of Jesus**



It is important that we teach our kids to pray using the power of the blood of Jesus. We have our victory through the blood of Jesus.

Pray through the lesson outline and that you will have a way to reach the kids to grow in applying the blood of Jesus on a daily basis.

### **Objective:**

- Teach kids the big deal about the blood of Jesus.
- Teach kids to pray using the blood of Jesus.

**Scripture:** Exodus 4-14 (read through all the chapters in preparation)

**Memory verse:** Leviticus 17:11

“...for the life of the body is in its blood. I have given you the blood on the altar to purify you, making you right with the LORD...”

**Declaration:** There is power in the blood of Jesus.

### **Opening Activity:**

Ask the kids if they know anything about blood –  
Continue to ask how they feel when they see blood

Teach some interesting facts:

**Blood** is a liquid in humans and many animals except insects. Blood is pushed through the organism by the heart, and brings nutrients and oxygen to our tissues. It also takes away waste and carbon dioxide from tissues.

Say: Today we are going to learn about the power of the blood of Jesus.

- God appeared and spoke to Moses out of the bush that was on fire, but didn't burn up, He sent Moses back to Egypt to free the Israelites from slavery.
- But when he got to Egypt, the wicked king Pharaoh said that he didn't believe in God and that he wouldn't let his slaves, the Israelites, go. He said he needed them to work!
- So, God punished Pharaoh and the Egyptians. First, he used Moses to turn all the water in Egypt into blood. Then, God made millions of frogs come bother the Egyptians. Next, God made millions of flies come.
- Then, God made all the Egyptians' cows and other farm animals die as a punishment to them. Then, he made them all get sores on their body that itched and hurt.
- Next, God made hail fall from the sky to destroy all the Egyptians' farm crops. Then, He made it totally dark everywhere in Egypt except where the Israelite slaves lived.
- God did all these things to the Egyptians because they wouldn't listen to Him and let the Israelites go out of slavery. Every time God punished the Egyptians, Pharaoh said he was sorry. He promised to let the Israelites go, but he never did. He always changed his mind.
- So, finally, God brought the greatest punishment on the Egyptians. First, he told the Israelites to all kill and eat a lamb (baby sheep) for dinner. They were to take some of the lamb's blood and put it on the doorframe of their houses.
- That night, God sent an angel through Egypt. The angel went into every house that didn't have the blood of a lamb on the doorframe and killed the oldest child he found there. He even killed the oldest child of Pharaoh himself.
- **The Israelites were saved because they had the blood of the lamb on their doorframes. The blood marked them as safe**, just like we marked the items that we want to keep. The Israelites called that night Passover because the angel passed over their houses.
- And we know that we're also saved from God's punishments by the blood of a lamb. The Bible calls Jesus the Lamb of God, and He was killed thousands of years later on the same day that the Israelites celebrate Passover.
- When Jesus died on the cross, His blood was shed to save us from sin and from the attack of the enemy. We are saved by His blood just like the Israelites were saved by the blood of a lamb.

#### **Application:**

Make declarations of the blood

- By the blood of Jesus, I have been redeemed from the power of the enemy.
- By the blood of Jesus, all my sins have been forgiven,
- Because I walk in the light and spend time with other Christians, the blood of Jesus cleanses me now and continually from all my sins.
- By the blood of Jesus, I am justified. God sees me as though I had never sinned.
- By the blood of Jesus, I am sanctified. I am set apart to do great things for God.
